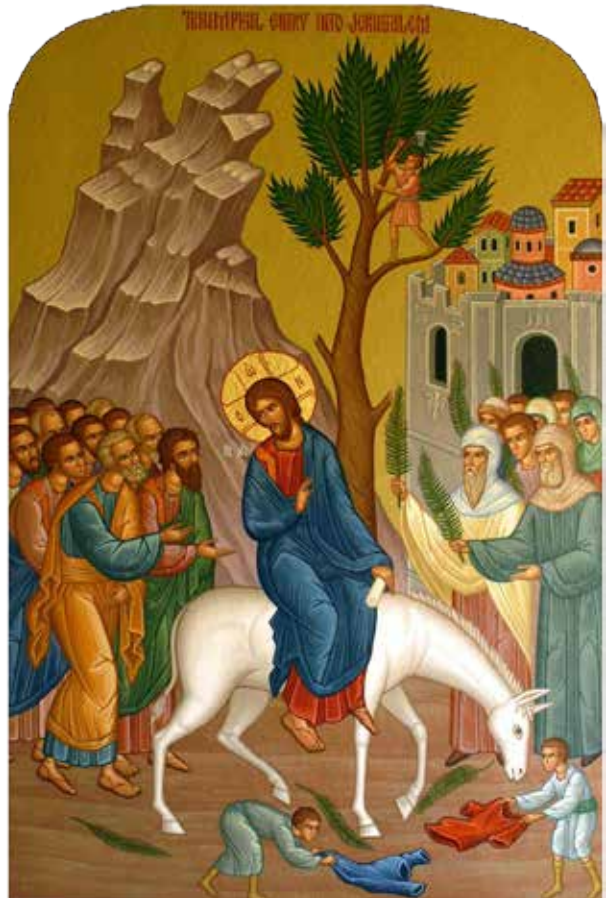

Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem

Epistle: Phil. 4:4-9 **Gospel:** John 12:1-18

We extend a **joyous welcome** to all our parishioners and guests that have come to join us this Sunday in offering praise to God.

Please join us for Pancakes following the 9 am & 11 am Divine Liturgies!

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday. As we commemorate Our Lord's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, let us all shout:

Blessed is He Who Comes in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the Highest!

At the conclusion of today's Divine Liturgy, as is the custom in our Ukrainian Catholic Church, the priest will bless **Pussy Willows**, which remind us of the liturgical symbolism of Palm Sunday. During the winter the willow tree seems to be dead. Yet, with the coming of spring, it sprouts and gives a sign of life. The willow branches bring to mind the wood of the Tree of the Cross, while the buds, a sign of new life, remind us of our own glorious resurrection. The faithful will also receive a special blessing through the anointing of one's forehead with Holy Oil. The priest will greet you with either, "Христос посеред нас!" or "Christ is Among Us!", to which one responds: "Є і буде!" or "He is and will be!"

SACRAMENTS

Baptism & Chrismation - for infants and adults; by arrangement in advance with the Pastor. For infants- the parents of the child to be baptized must personally meet with the Pastor on Sunday after one of the Divine Liturgies prior to making arrangements with the Parish Office.

Holy Matrimony (Marriage) - please make an appointment with the Pastor at least six months in advance. All couples are required to attend the Marriage Preparation Program held usually during the Lenten season and are expected to be active members of the church community.
