## EXCITING NEW PROJECT...

As mentioned in the Fall of 2018, the Front Plaza (Courtyard) is need of substantial repair. A concept drawing was presented to the parish during an Open House Meeting in last November where parishioners were encouraged to give their feedback on the project. The Project Committee has taken many of the ideas expressed during that meeting and have incorporated them into the project plans. In the next few weeks, each parishioner will receive a letter with further information on this project. At its last meeting, Parish Council has secured terms for financing this project, and construction is set begin shortly after the frost has disappeared from the ground. The project is expected to cost \$192,000 and will require approximately 10 weeks to complete. Parish Council asks for your generosity towards funding this necessary project. ## SACRAMENTS

**Baptism & Chrismation** - for infants and adults; by arrangement in advance with the Pastor. For infants- the parents of the child to be baptized must personally meet with the Pastor on Sunday after one of the Divine Liturgies prior to making arrangements with the Parish Office.
