**Icon of the Sunday of St. Thomas**

**Epistle:** Acts 5:12-20 **Gospel:** John 20:19-31

We extend a **joyous welcome** to all our parishioners and guests that have come to join us this Sunday of St. Thomas in offering praise to God, as we continue to celebrate Our Lord's Glorious Resurrection. At the conclusion of today's Divine Liturgy, as is the custom in our Ukrainian Catholic Church, the faithful will receive a special blessing through the anointing of one's forehead with Holy Oil. The priest will greet you with either, "**Христос Воскрес!**" or "**Christ is Risen!**", to which one responds: **Воістину Воскрес!**" or "**Indeed He is Risen!**" The faithful will also receive a piece of the Blessed "Artos" or Easter Bread that is reserved on the Altar for the entire week. On Thomas Sunday (the Sunday following Easter) the Artos is cut into small cubes and distributed to the faithful following the Divine Liturgy.

## EXCITING NEW PROJECT...

As mentioned in the Fall of 2018, the Front Plaza (Courtyard) is in need of substantial repair. A concept drawing was presented to the parish during an Open House Meeting in last November where parishioners were encouraged to give their feedback on the project. The Project Committee has taken many of the ideas expressed during that meeting and have incorporated them into the project plans. In the next few weeks, each parishioner will receive a letter with further information on this project. At its last meeting, Parish Council has secured terms for financing this project, and construction is set to begin shortly after the frost has disappeared from the ground. The project is expected to cost \$192,000, the construction to begin mid-June (weather dependent) and will require approximately 10 weeks to complete. ## SACRAMENTS
