## SUPPORT IN UNCERTAIN TIMES

In order to help curb the spread of the COVID-19 virus and in accordance with the health regulations of the Manitoba Provincial Government, St. Nicholas Church has temporarily closed its doors to people at this time. The Basilian priests resident in the monastery will be celebrating the scheduled liturgies, but without the presence of the public. Many of the liturgical services will be livestreamed and links will be posted to this page.

Our primary concern is the health and well-being of our parishioners and those in our community. However, without public liturgical services being held in the church and the suspension of public fundraising activities, the parish has lost a large portion of its revenue. It will be a challenge for St. Nick's parish to maintain operations without the weekly offertory collection. There are several ways that a parishioner can continue to support St. Nick's at this time:

### SACRAMENTS

**Baptism & Chrismation** - for infants and adults; by arrangement in advance with the Pastor. For infants- the parents of the child to be baptized must personally meet with the Pastor on Sunday after one of the Divine Liturgies prior to making arrangements with the Parish Office.
