## HOLY APOSTLE & EVANGELIST JOHN THE THEOLOGIAN

John's father was Zebedee, the fisherman. When John was called by Jesus, he together with his brother James left their father and their fishing nets and followed the Lord. From that time, John stayed with Jesus to the end. John, together with Peter and James, were present at the raising of Jairus's daughter and at the Lord's Transfiguration. At the Last Supper John had leaned back and laid his head on Jesus's chest. Even though everyone had abandoned Jesus at His crucifixion, John stayed beneath the Cross together with Mary the Mother of God. In obedience to our Lord, he took care of Mary as one would take care of his own mother. He cared for her right up to her Dormition. John went with his disciple Prochorus, one of the seven deacons ordained in Acts 6:5-6, to preach the Gospel in Asia Minor and mainly in Ephesus.

Through his inspired preaching and miracles, he brought many to Christ and showed everyone the falseness of paganism. The troubled pagans bound him and sent him to the Roman Emperor Domitian. There, John was tortured and flogged, but he was unharmed by the poison that was given him to drink and the boiling oil into which he was put. Because of this, the Emperor was afraid, thinking he was immortal. He then sent John into exile on the Greek island of Patmos. In a cave, on this island, St. John experienced many miraculous visions. Tradition has it that his deacon, Prochorus wrote down everything that John had dictated to him, and it is now known as the book of Revelations. John is also the author of the Gospel of St. John and the epistles of St. John.

When Emperor Nerva, gave liberty to all the captives, John returned to Ephesus. He was over a hundred years old when he died. Sometime later, his disciples opened his grave and found that his body was not there. Every year, on May 8th, a fine fragrant dust endowed with healing power rose from his grave.
