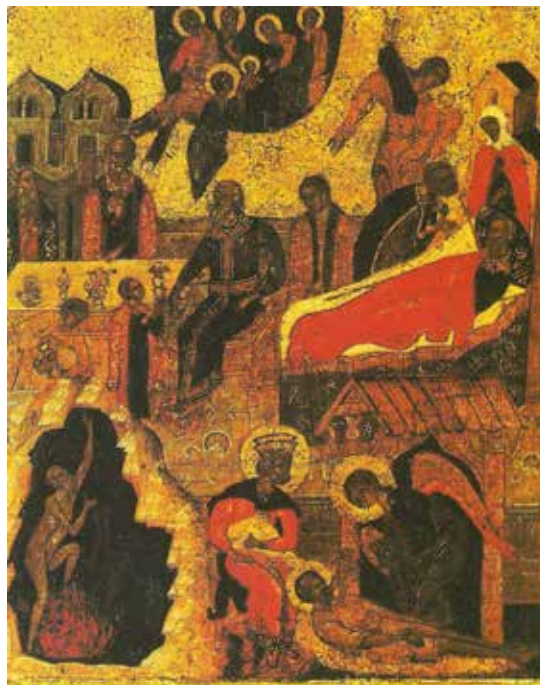

Arethas was the **prefect** of the **Christian city** of **Negran**, situated in **southern Arabia**. At that time, in the **sixth century**, southern Arabia was ruled by a **Jewish man** named **King Dunaan**. He was a terrible **persecutor of Christians** and issued an edict that all followers of Christ were to be put to death if they did not reject Christ.¹ The people of Negran were faithful to Christ, so Dunaan the king came with a large army so as to destroy this city. Since the **city was well fortified**, the king's men announced that only those who would renounce Christ, and call His Cross a "sign of malediction" would be spared.² The city gates remained closed. Then **Dunaan swore an oath** to the people that he would do them no harm if they would just **open the gates** so that he could **collect the tax** that was due to him and then he would leave.³

The **people** believed Dunaan and **opened the gate** to the city even though Saint Arethas tried to convince them not to do so. With the city gates wide open, Dunaan gathered **427 clergy** and had them **all burn in a large fire**. **Arethas** and other **men of authority** were **thrown in prison**. Then Dunaan sent his messengers to the people so as to convert the Christians to Judaism saying, "... I want merely that you **do not believe in Jesus Christ**, since the **Crucified One was a man, and not God**." The **people responded**, "We shall not abandon Christ, since He is Life for us. **To die for Him is to find Life**."⁴

In total, **4,299** men, women, the nuns, the aged and the children were slaughtered and **died as martyrs** for the faith in **523 AD**.⁶ Arethas was 95 years old at the time of his martyrdom.⁷

Later during the time of Emperor Justin (518-527)⁸ an Ethiopian Emperor Elesbaan, came and destroyed Dunaan and his entire army. St Gregory (feast day: Dec. 19th) was installed as the archbishop of Negran and the **Christians** there **rebuilt the Church of the Holy Trinity** that Dunaan had burned, and **built another church to the Holy Martyrs Arethas and those who had died with him**.⁹
