CHRIST THE KING

The solemnity which the Church celebrates today reminds us once again of the time of the Last Judgment, of the power and justice of the King. In the role of just king appears Jesus himself, the King of glory - the Lord mighty and powerful, the Lord of forces (see. Ps. 24:8-10), who seeks to do justice. "But grace and truth came through Jesus Christ" (Jn. 1:17).

"... Inherit the Kingdom". From a legal point of view, the right to inherit has a person who was in a close family relationship with the testator.

It turns out that Jesus chose each one of us as his heir, and each one of us can inherit the Kingdom only when we have this close relationship with Him - "father and daughter/son".

"Blessed of the Father" - who that can be? We will get a clear answer by looking at the verse from the book of Deuteronomy and the Gospel of St. Luke: "See, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse: a blessing for obeying the commandments of the LORD, your God, which I give you today; a curse if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD, your God, but turn aside from the way I command you today, to go after other gods, whom you do not know" (Deut. 11:26-28); "Rather, blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it" (Lk 11:28).

The main prerequisites that Jesus points to in order to inherit the Kingdom at first glance are simple, but the question is; do I always agree to fulfill them? Am I ready to give up bodily, material goods, or am I ready to accept a stranger - a person to whom I do not feel friendly, who does not agree with my views? Or: how often did the beggar on the street made me look the other way? My statement of my action towards my neighbor is my answer, apparently, I'm not ready.

Your unreadiness will last until you say "yes" to Him. By receiving and accepting the body of Christ into your dark dungeon, into your life, you will first allow yourself to be fed (the Holy Eucharist), to be watered by His Word, to be clothed in new clothes, to be healed of spiritual suffering and attachment, to be freed from the trap of sin in general. As a result, you will be able to do this to others, you will be able to fulfill all the prerequisites to become a full-fledged heir to the Kingdom.
