INTER-RELIGIOUS DIALOGUE

2025 marks the 60th anniversary of the promulgation of Nostra Aetate, the Vatican II Declaration on the Relation of the Church to Non-Christian Religions. The Winnipeg Bat Kol Tri-Diocesan Committee is beginning that celebration by welcoming Dr. Murray Watson, SSL, PhD, theology professor, adult faith formation animator and teacher who has taught widely across Canada, in Europe and the Holy Land on biblical and interfaith topics.

Dr. Watson will present a Friday evening conference on the radicality of this Vatican II document and asking where are we, 60 years later? He will then offer Saturday conferences on an interfaith pioneer, André Chouraqui, a pioneer in interreligious dialogue amongst Jewish, Christian and Muslim faiths.

Chouraqui is unique in the world of interreligious dialogue in that he has personally translated the Hebrew scriptures, the Christian New Testament as well as the Muslim Quran. The conference will take place at St. Paul's College, University of Manitoba, on Friday, January 31 and Saturday, February 1. Ample free parking is available across from St. Paul's College in Lot Q.
