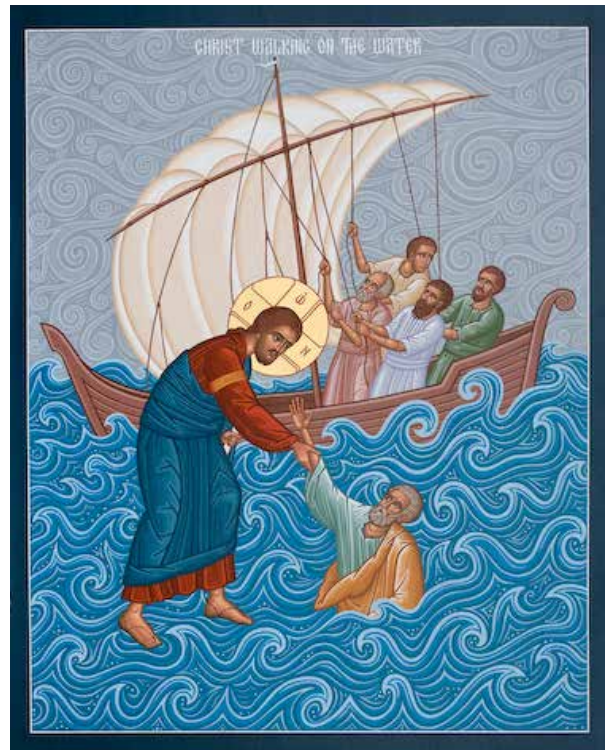

St. Nicholas UCWLC is offering a scholarship of \$1000 to students of Ukrainian descent, whose parents or guardians are members at St. Nicholas Church. APPEAL: CHURCH PARKING LOT & STAIRS

Over many years, several sections of the church parking lot have sunk to the point that large areas have water collecting and now the asphalt paving is deteriorating. In addition, the stairs to the back parking lot entrance have sunken and need to be replaced.
